



# Dairy Lac Duo



*For use as a foam, dip or spray directly pre and post milking  
Ready to use teat foam, spray, dip and udder wash for dairy cows*

## **For best results:**

### **PRE MILKING**

Apply Dairy Lac Duo by spraying or dipping using foaming teat cup. Ensure the length of the teats are fully covered. Allow 30 seconds for activity and remove using a single service paper towel. If dipping, carefully empty and clean teat dip cups after every milking. Refill teat cups at each milking.

### **POST MILKING**

Immediately after milking apply Dairy Lac Duo by spraying or dipping. Ensure that at least 2/3 of the length of the teats are covered. If dipping, carefully empty and clean teat cups after every milking. Refill teat cups at each milking.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

## SAFETY AND HANDLING
